4. TK-9th Update- Kevin Hood TK-9th Principal and Jessup McGregor, Head of Schools

- a. Teacher retention: 19/20 teachers came back from our previous years
- b. The school needs to hire one more teacher's aide. Work day is Monday-Friday,
 8am-1pm. Applicants can complete an application through the ACS website under the
 "Join Our Team" link.
- c. Middle school- 6,7,8th has been going well overall, there has been a lot of change for these students and families.
- d. High school- 24 students, every single new hire has 10+ years of experience in their subject.
- e. Our school population is almost at 900 kids from preschool high school
- f. New things- launched high school, piloting a home-school program, currently it's a partnership with other homeschool families so they can take classes with us and extend our reach into the community.



- g. This school year, we will be working towards the accreditation process for approval by the Western Association of Schools and College (WASC) in addition to ACSI, who we are members of already.
- h. We are about to be approved High school athletics through the CA interscholastic Federation, who governs all California high school sports.
- i. Athletic field is still in the works.
- j. ACS is building out a practice facility at Bayside Blue Oaks with a full sized basketball court for our students because A101 is too small for a full sized court. We are using funds that were raised through the Warrior Run and Auction Dinner last 2022/23 school year.
- k. Safety measures increased on campus, administration is working to have all school buildings have locked doors during the school day, allowing access to the buildings via a buzzer. Middle School/High school building still needs to be completed.
- I. ACS Cafe inherited from the church- ACS now owns and runs the cafe. Prices were decreased.
 - i. Volunteers needed during the week. 6-9th graders are able to use the cafe during the school day for lunches and snacks.
 - ii. Volunteer hours- 7am (teaching staff)-4pm, 8am will be open to parents depending on volunteers, open on Sundays.
 - iii. Use admin QR code to sign up to volunteer.
 - iv. Cafe funds go directly back to the school, as of now it will go to the general fund
- m. Parent committee for the middle school/high school classes in place of specific room moms per teacher. The sign up form will be sent out in this weekend's text newsletter.
