- b. Administration is reviewing applicants for the staff openings that have come available.
- c. The PA system and cameras are all now installed.
- d. The shade structures for the pick up areas are still in the works, they are working through the structural requirements for the shade structures at this time.

  - ii. K-8- 96% enrolled
- f. ACS finances are very good.
  - i. To help keep our finances going strong, ACS is working on creating an Endowment fund to help support the school and offset Tuition costs and more. This is something to help the school in the long term.

- g. High school update
  - i. Home meetings have started and are going well. ACS families will continue to be informed of all updates along the way.
- h. ACS is Partnering with The Salvation Army during the holiday system. There will be an Angel tree on campus to help support families in need. Criteria for Angel Tree-\$50 gift card toward clothing, shoes and jacket and pick a gift on their wishlist.
- i. The Christmas program is on Friday, December 10, 2022. Administration is coming up with ideas to help with the stress over getting seats and to make the seating process run smoothly. In the past people had to arrive 1-2 hours before to get to the front of the line and then it can get contentious among the crowd when they open the doors and everyone is rushing to get their seats.
- j. Sports field update: 82% funded on field, permitting is done and we are needing a final amount of 238K to finish the field. There is going to be a donation link on the ACS website for those that would like to donate money to go directly to the field to help reach our total needed for completion. The Athletic field is important because it's one of the first steps toward making our high school possible.
