1. 87% current TK-10th have reenrolled

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- 2. 13% availability for new enrollees, working to get all students that we can into our school.
- 3. Preschool is over 50% capacity for current students reenrolling
- 4. High school numbers- we have the capacity to expand if needed but we currently have 1 class per grade.
 - a. new implementations for new students coming into 6th-10th grade- looking at behavioral documents, statement of faith.
 - b. Class limit for elementrary is 25 students, there are rare circumstances where a class may have one or two over but that doesn't happen often.
